### Joëlle Mekers (Executive Vice President)

Ms. Mekers has more than 20 years' corporate finance experience, chiefly in the project and structured finance area, including considerable advisory work in the media & telecommunications sector. Based in New York for the past three years, she has provided support to major clients, resulting in numerous high-profile deals across various sectors, such as infrastructure, utilities and mining.
